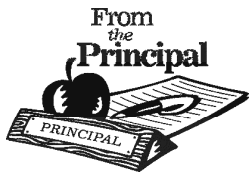
## SUNDAY SCHOOL

There will be NO Sunday School on Sunday, December 25<sup>th</sup>.

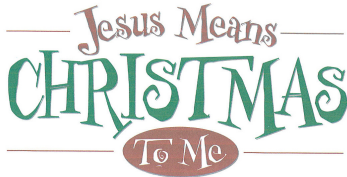


## BADGER SPORTS DAY
