JR YOUTH: March 8th from 6-8pm. Devotion: God's Plan

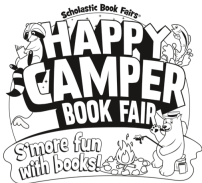
SR AND JR YOUTH OVERNIGHT LOCK-IN - February 24-25th
