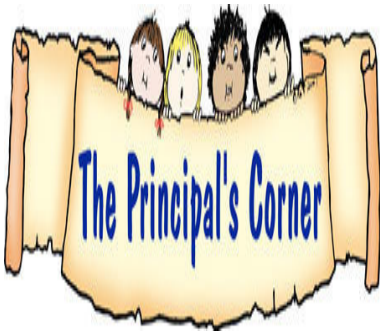

- + **Diarrhea**
- + **Vomiting**
- + **Unidentified rash**
- + **Open sores – especially on the face and hands**
- + **Red runny eyes**
- + **Feeling too uncomfortable to participate in school**

If your child exhibits any of these symptoms in the morning, please keep him/her home.
