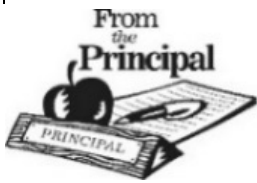

REPORT CARD AVAILABLE FOR PICK-UP ON FRIDAY, JUNE 9TH

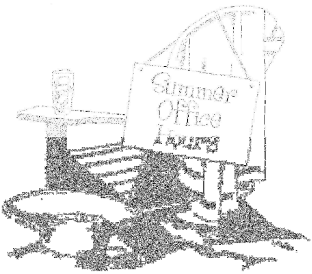
Please be aware if you have an outstanding lunch account or tuition balance, you will not be able to pick up your child's report card until balances are paid in full. Thank you.

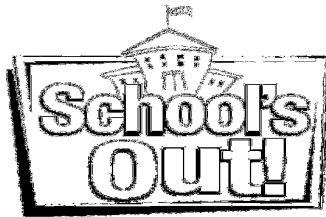
HAVE YOU REGISTRERED FOR THE NEW SCHOOL YEAR?
