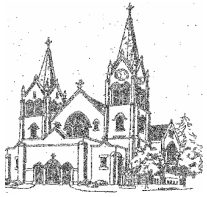


## **Steak Sandwich Dinner**

- 50% church attendance August 1, 2016 - July 2017, member tuition rate will apply. If attendance of 50% or greater has not been met, non-member rates will be charged for the 2017-2018 school year. Church attendance will be reviewed August 1<sup>st</sup> of each year to determine your tuition rate for the upcoming school year. Attendance will be recorded from attendance cards at church.
