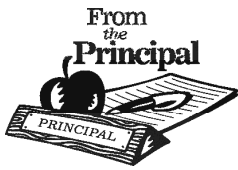

PARENT / TEACHER CONFERENCES – KINDERGARTEN - 8TH GRADE

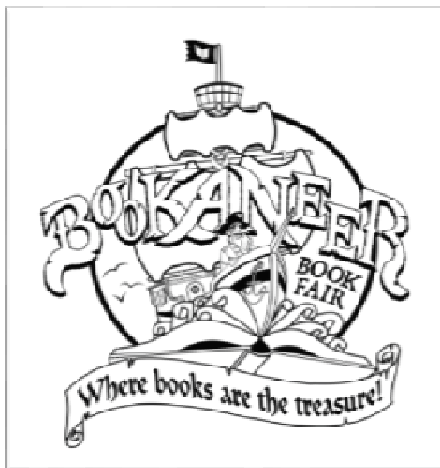
Conferences will be held on November 17th & 18th. Please watch for a note from your child's teacher indicating the scheduled time of your conference. Thank you.

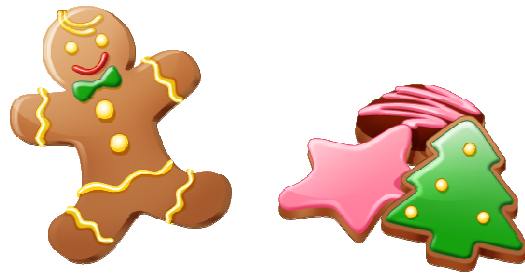
