DID YOU KNOW?

In 1936, the Senior Young People's Society started the publication of the Sunday bulletin in December.

The entire church basement was then remodeled to make one large room at a cost of \$1,430.00. Concordia Hall, as it was named, was completed in 1936.

In 1939, the Men's Club and the Ladies' Aid purchased the flags that are displayed in our church.

In 1940, hearing aid equipment and amplifying system were installed by a number of merchants of the city.

In 1941, hymnal racks were installed on our church pews and our new blue English hymnals were put into use on November 9.

In 1953, radio broadcasting of our services was approved.
