## NO BUSSING ON FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 4<sup>TH</sup>

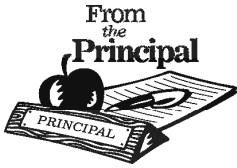
The Reedsburg Public Schools do not have school on Friday, November 4<sup>th</sup>, and therefore St. Peter's will not have bussing.
