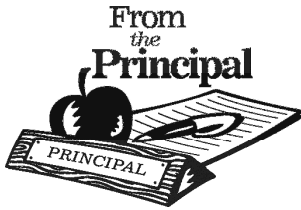
Students should arrive at Concordia Hall 15 minutes before the service begins to warm up.

SCHOOL SPIRIT DAY

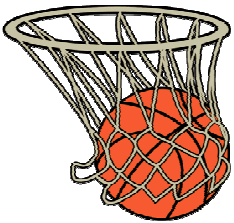
