Thursday: Bring a personalized gift (a few ideas: lotion, lip balm, ink pen, stamp pad, or get crafty!)

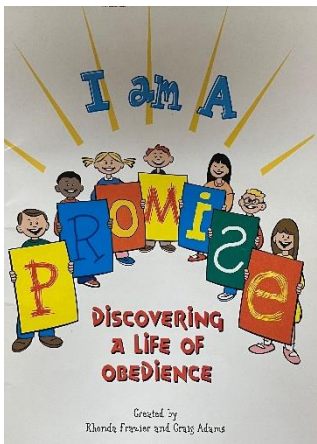
Friday: Bring Your Teacher a beverage (coffee, soda, tea, decorated water bottle, etc)

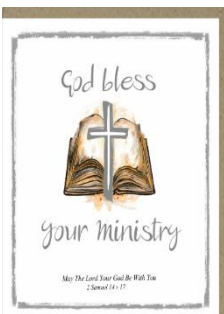
