SUPER BOWL FOOD DRIVE



ACHIEVEMENT TESTING

St. Peter's students in grades 3-8 will be taking the State Forward Exam this year. This test is an online test. All students in grades 3-8 are tested in the areas of English Language Arts (ELA) and Math. Students in grades 4 and 8 have additional testing in Science and Social Studies. Students are practicing how to test in this new format at school. You can practice at home as well using this link: Wisconsin Forward Exam Online Training Tools and Samples. Students in grades 1st and 2nd will continue to use the lowa Basic Skills paper and pencil test we have used in the past. Dates for testing will begin late March, early April.
