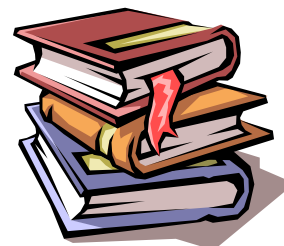
GRANDPARENTS – PLEASE JOIN US FOR A SPECIAL DAY

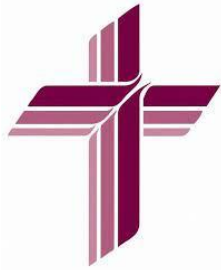
