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### **ST. PETER'S \*\*\* IS WISCONSIN SCHOOL CHOICE**

This program is a state-wide program that allows families to apply for state aid that will cover your tuition cost to attend St. Peter's School. Currently this program is available for the 2023-2024 school year for St. Peter's students entering PRE-K 4, Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade, or students that are new to St. Peter's in PRE-K 4 - 8<sup>th</sup> grade. ### **TUITION TAX DEDUCTION AVAILABLE**

Tax season is quickly approaching. And a simple form can help your families deduct up to \$4,000 for K-8 grade tuition and \$10,000 for 9-12 grade tuition on their state income taxes.

This state tax deduction has been available since 2014, thanks to WCRIS advocacy and your support. The deduction saves private school families nearly \$8 million per year. The state budgets for around \$12 million per year so **there is room for more families to use the deduction.**

### **CHURCH ATTENDANCE FOR MEMBER TUITION RATE**

Members who attended services at St. Peter's Lutheran Church at least 26 times between August 1, and July 30, will receive the discounted member rate. Non-members who attend services at St. Peter's Lutheran Church at least 9 times between August 1, and July 30, will receive the discounted non-member rate.

Dear parent or guardian,

This letter is to notify you that [a] child[ren] or staff member[s] in our school at St. Peter's has tested positive for COVID-19. We are providing you this notification so you may take appropriate actions to stay safe and healthy. We are also cleaning and disinfecting the facility to control the spread of illness.

### **About COVID-19**

COVID-19 is an illness caused by a coronavirus. It spreads from person to person through droplets created when we cough, sneeze, talk, sing or laugh. Most people—especially young people—who get COVID-19 have mild illness, similar to having a cold or the flu. However, in others it can cause severe illness, such as pneumonia. Symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- Fever (temperature 100.4°F or higher)
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Chills
- Sore throat
- New loss of taste or smell
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Fatigue
- Muscle/body aches
- Congestion or runny nose
- Headache

### **Prevent Further Spread**

The following guidelines will help to prevent further spread of illness at St. Peter's:

- Notify St. Peter' if your child is diagnosed with COVID-19.
