ACADEMIC SKILLS TESTING

Two classes will be scheduled to do testing during the same time frame, as Chromebook and strong internet access are required to complete the testing. 1st and 2nd grade students will take the IOWA Skills test April 12 – April 21st. Your child's teacher will inform you as to when this testing will take place. The majority of testing will be conducted in the mornings. It has been proven that a good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast will help students perform to their highest level. Also, please make every effort to have your child in attendance during these tests. All tests have to be made up and it is very difficult for teachers to fit this into their daily routine once the testing days are over.
