Mission Weekend Nov. 18 & 19 Our mission speaker today is Rev. John Suguitan. He is an SMP pastor (Specific Ministry Pastor program - Concordia St. Louis), with the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod (LCMS). He has a specific focus on Inner-City ministries. He has been serving Prince of Peace Lutheran Church for over 20 years. Prince of Peace is an inner-city church in the Over-the-Rhine neighborhood in Cincinnati. This church has stood for over 150 years and continues to shine the light of Jesus; Salvation for all God's children. Prince of Peace Lutheran Church has been, and continues to be a diverse church in the Over-the-Rhine /Cincinnati community. Prince of Peace has a long history of serving those struggling within the cycle of poverty, those experiencing homelessness, those with addictions, lack of education, and to all people whatever their struggles, regardless of race and economic status. Pastor Suguitan will give a presentation on the mission work being done after our 9 a.m. service on Sunday in the sanctuary. There also will be a clear box in the Narthex for a freewill offering to help support mission work of Prince of Peace. Pastor Suguitan is fighting blood cancer. He will be wearing a mask during the service and will not be sharing the Peace. He needs to keep his immune system from being compromised so that he is able to undergo a second blood stem cell transplant. By Gods' grace and will, it is hoped that this will cure him of cancer.
