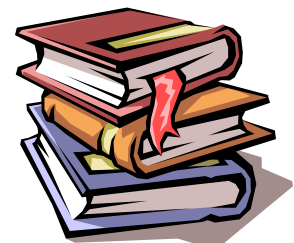
GRANDPARENTS – PLEASE JOIN US FOR A SPECIAL DAY

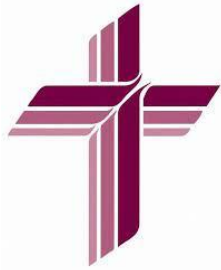

CARLINE PICKUP SYSTEM

The current Carline system will be used the rest of the year and will become our main Carline Pickup System. The advantage of this system is we do not block any driveways. Please remember that the traffic on Locust Street does not have a stop sign. Use caution as you make the left turn onto Locust street.

As a Reminder

BLUE SIGNS FAMILIES will wait on Locust Street starting at the corner of Locust and 3rd street. Wait for the signal to move into the parking lot. **Remember not to block driveways as you line up.** Please also remember to turn right as you leave the parking lot.

CARLINE - The line will start at the corner of Locust and Third Street. Vehicles will be parallel to the curb of City Park and in the parking areas. It will then extend down North Park Street and up 2nd street if needed. (See Map). Be sure there is space in front of the church for you to pull into as you wait to enter the parking lot. Please also remember to turn right as you leave the parking lot.
